

The Virginia Neonatal Perinatal Collaborative (VNPC) is recruiting for the Obstetric Co-Chair position, which will be held by a respected, high-level obstetric health professional with statewide influence. The Obstetric Co-Chair must have an advanced degree (Masters, APRN, or Doctorate) and be actively working in the women's (maternal) health field in Virginia. This position is a three-year appointment, beginning July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2028.

Responsibilities include, but aren't limited to the following:

- 1. Promote VNPC vision and activities.
- 2. Participate actively in decisions regarding activities of the VNPC.
- 3. Seek approval from Strategic Advisory Committee for any activities or decisions regarding direction of the VNPC.
- 4. Assist with content and presenters for annual meetings.
- 5. Assist and approve budget and expenditures.
- 6. Treat other members of the Leadership Committee with respect, giving all an equal voice.
- 7. Work directly with the Senior Director of the VNPC to provide guidance and advice for email and constituent responses, interviews, and other sensitive responses/feedback.
- 8. Attend weekly Leadership Committee meetings, monthly Strategic Advisory Committee meetings and other meetings as scheduled.
- 9. Participate in AIM monthly meetings and training calls.
- 10. Provide relevant literature and current OB practices to the Senior Director of the VNPC and leadership committee for opportunities to improve maternal health.
- 11. Have experience in quality improvement or be willing to become educated in performing QI projects.
- 12. Have the expertise required to review, participate in, and supervise quality improvement projects and other clinical programs.

This position will require about 5-10 hours of time per week and currently is a volunteer position.
